Stakeholder Forum

Stakeholder Forum is a multi-stakeholder organisation, which has been working to further the implementation of the sustainable development agenda since 1992. The organisation operates at the national, regional and international level by providing space for dialogue and policy development between stakeholders and stakeholders and governments. This includes: local government, trade unions, industry, NGOs, women groups, youth, education groups, scientists and academics, media and regional governments. In addition we work closely with UN agencies addressing the environment and development issues by capacity building stakeholders and raising awareness. These agencies principally include: the UN Commission on Sustainable Development, UNEP, UNEP, WHO.

Stakeholder Forum has played an important role in the development of stakeholder dialogues at the global level. It has also been the facilitator of the multi-stakeholder dialogues at the following meetings:

- Promoting multistakeholder processes
- Researching and influencing policy development
- Providing and spreading information on the intergovernmental agenda
- Training and capacity building

To communicate the work of sustainable development Stakeholder Forum has two publications. These are a monthly online newsletter **Network 2005** and its sister publication **Outreach 2005** which comes out daily at different UN meetings.
